## Romans: Living Out the Gospel

*Romans 12:9-21*

Is there a main point of these commands?

- Paul begins with an overarching command to love.
- The love referred to is *agape*, Christ-like love, gospel love.
- Love is central to the gospel, which is why it must be without hypocrisy.

### Gospel Love in Action (vv.9-16)

Gospel love...

### Gospel Love Applied (vv. 17-21)
